## O R D E R

In the Government order read above, Government have prescribed the rates of rent of lease or licence of land and trees under the Kerala Land Assignment Rules, 1964. In the land decade the value of land as well as the usufructs of the trees have increased steeply. Therefore Government have considered the question of revising the rate of rent in consultation with the Board of Revenue and re-pleased to order that the rates of rent for land and trees leased or licenced under the Kerala Land Assignment Rules 1964 prescribed in the Government order read above, no revised as below:-

## I. Rate of rent for land (vide rule 13).

Dry land	: Rs. 1.60 per cent per annum
wet land (single) crops	: Rs. 150 per cent per annum
wet land (double crops)	: Rs. 2.25 per cent

## II. Rate of rent for bearing trees (vide rule 17 &amp; 18):

coconut Tree	: Rs. 50/- tree per annum
macanut trees	: Rs. 25/- "
Jack	: Rs. 13/- "
Palmyran	: Rs. 2/- "
Chamind	: Rs. 25/- "
Jujube	: Rs. 2/- "
Cashew	: Rs. 25/- "
Paper Pine	: Rs. 21/- "
Mango	: Rs. 25/- "

## III. Rent for lease or licence of land under Rule 13(A) for purposes other than summer pendal.

Suitable rates according to the occasion subject to a minimum of 15/- percent per day.

## IV. Putting up of Summer pendals.

: Rs. 0.75 per cent per subject to minimum of 75 Rs.

## Rent in respect of leases and licences under rule 13(f).

Rotting of coconut husks	: Rs. 6/- per cent per annum
Stocking of materials	: Rs. 75 "
Use as play ground	: Rs. 0.25 "
Putting up drainage covering & construction of steps on road margin	: Rs. 45 per cent

|| Putting up shops in : 15% the market value of land  
baser areas subject to a minimum of  
Rs.120/- per cent per annum.

Putting up shops in other : 10% of the market value of  
areas land subject to a minimum of  
Rs.45/- per cent per annum.

Such other purposes as : Rate to be fixed by Govt. in  
may be decided by Govt. each case.

Rates for Rubber-Coffee and tea:

Yielding Rubber pants Rs.15/- per plant per annum.

Yielding Coffee plants Rs.7.50 per "

Yielding Tea plants Rs.1.50 per plant per annum.

a. Land for laying of Pipe lines  
for carrying water subject to ~  
a minimum of Rs.10/- for drinking  
or irrigation purposes.

b. Land for laying of Pipe  
lines for movement of oil 10% per cent per annum subject  
for commercial purposes. to a minimum of Rs.10/-

Land for constructions of : 10% of the market value of land  
Petrol bunks. in Panchayat areas and 15% of the  
market value of land in Municipal  
Corporation on Township areas  
as fixed in G.O.Ms.738/72/RD  
dated 22.7.72.

2. The revised rates will apply to all cases of leases  
renewed or sanctioned afresh from the date of this order.
