The Kerala Revenue service special Rules were published vide Government Orders read as 1st and 2nd above. Rule 7 of Kerala Revenue service (Tahsildar) Special Rules published as per Government order read as 2nd, envisages that every person appointed as Tahsildar shall from the date on which he/she joints duty, be on probation for total period of two years on duty, within continuous period of three years.

According to Rule 8 of the Kerala Revenue Service (Tahsildar) Special Rules read as 2nd above, every person appointed as Tahsildar, before declaring completion of his/her probation successfully, undergo Magisterial Training for a period of 8 Weeks (6 weeks in the police Department and 2 weeks in the Judicial Department) as included in the Annexure to these Rules, if he/she has not undergone the training before appointment to the service.

On account of Government order read as 3rd above, the Special Rules have amended and envisaged that the period of declaration of probation in the cadre of Tahsildar/Senior Superintendent shall be as one year on duty within continuous period of two years and the person who is appointed as Tahsildar shall undergo Police and Magisterial Training before declaration of probation successfully as stipulated in Rule 8 of the Special Rules.

The District Collectors have submitted proposals for declaration of probation successfully, in the cadre of Tahsildar/ Senior Superintendent vide letters read as 4th to 7th, regarding Sri. Jayachandran.P.P Sri. Madhusoodanan Pillai.R, Smt. Jessy Kutty Mathew and Smt. Jessy John respectively. On examining the data as received, the incumbents are eligible to be declared their probation since they have completed Police and Magisterial Training within continuous period of two years on duty, as stipulated in Rule 8 of Kerala Revenue Service (Tahsildar) Special Rules.

Having regard to the facts as examined, probation of the incumbents mentioned above, in the cadre of Tahsildar/ Senior Superintendent, are declared to have satisfactorily completed in the forenoon of the date as shown in the column number nine of the list as appended.
