ORDER

The Commissioner, Land Revenue vide letter read above has reported that during the flood 2019, a software has been developed by C-DiT as per his guidance for the effective management of camp inmates all over the state and also for the effective distribution of immediate financial assistance to them. Through this software 4,06,351 number of inmates in 2,187 camps spanning 77 Taluks has been identified and assistance disbursed to them. The software has proved to be a fool proof one during its use. It is imperative to develop two modules as an add-on to the current module, one to assess the damages of houses and for the disbursement of financial assistance and the other to monitor the utilization of funds disbursed for these purpose.

2) It is also reported that the software can be converted to a comprehensive disaster management portal enabling the department to map the vulnerable areas, filtering the data as per various queries like the assessment of damages, age group of beneficiaries etc. The software features can be shared with other Departments for their inputs, if needed. It is reported that C-DiT has expressed their consent to develop the additional modules if they are entrusted with the work. The work of development of the modules need to be taken up urgently before the next monsoon and has requested to give permission to entrust C-DiT for the same along with provision for the charges of development of software.

3) Government have examined the proposal in detail and is pleased to accord sanction to the Land Revenue Commissioner for entrusting the C-DiT for developing the additional modules for comprehensive disaster management portal enabling the disaster map to the vulnerable areas, filtering the data as per various queries like the assessment of damages, age group of beneficiaries.
